"THE citizens should be equally cautious about fulfilling their constitutional duties as they are demanding about their Constitutional Rights," said Dr Vipin Itankar, District Collector, while delivering a special lecture to mark Constitution Day on Tuesday. The programme was held at Niyojan Bhavan. Vinayak Mahamuni, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad Nagpur; Tushar Thombre, Upper district Collector; Kishor Gajbhiye, former chartered officer; Anup Khande, resident deputy Collector; Sukeshani Telgote, Assistant Commissioner, Social Welfare department along with other officials were present for the programme.

Dr Itankar emphasised the need to become a responsible citizen and embrace the values of Indian constitution.
